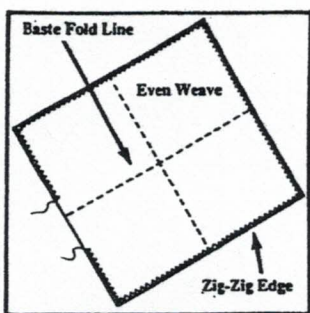


WINNIPEG EMBROIDERERS' GUILD NAME TAG

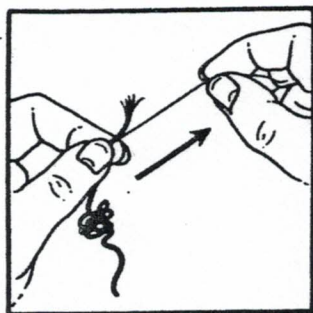
Supplies: Ribband, DMC floss #602, needle, pattern sheet and logo.

Use two strands of floss when working the cross stitches.

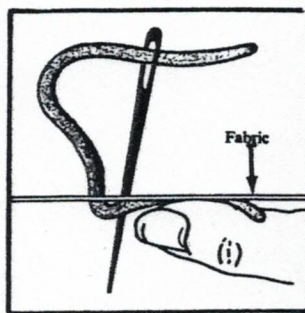
The location of the logo is up to you. Consider how your name will best fit on the ribband. Two examples are given on this sheet. You must choose the best way to do your name. (Other members will want to be able to read your name tag!) If needed, stitch your name in backstitch.



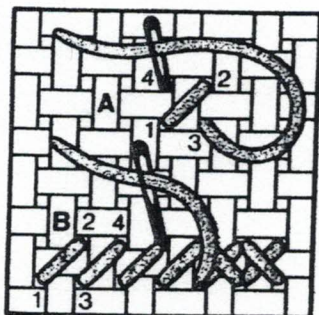
1. If you are cross stitching on evenweave fabric, fold fabric to find the center and baste along fold lines. Zig-zag edges.



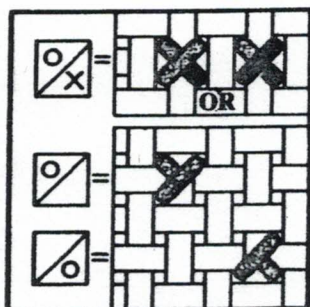
2. Cut floss into 15" lengths and separate all six strands. Re-combine the number of strands needed.



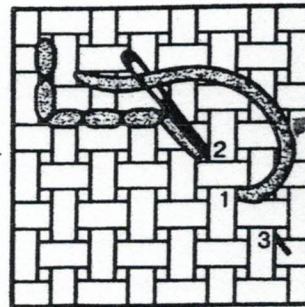
3. Begin by pushing needle up through fabric back. Hold loose end and pull thread up through fabric. Secure with first few stitches.



4. Make one cross stitch for each symbol on chart (A). For horizontal rows stitch all the way across, then work back (B). End by weaving through back of stitches.



5. 1/2 and 3/4 stitches are used to achieve rounded shapes.



6. Backstitches are added last to outline and define.
